Project Brief. New construction of a early learning center including civil works, Car Park and landscaping.

The Building consisted of two large classroom areas to be utilized for play, learning and nap times. A toilet and amenities room equipped for pre school children and a store room separated the two classrooms. The building also comprises of an administration office, principal office, canteen, staff room and staff toilets, Laundry and secure front entry foyer.

The two classrooms open out to the enclosed play yard via double glazed doors. A verandah built of Colourbond roof sheeting and Polycarb roof sheeting enables plenty of light to filter into the classrooms and verandah but maintains sun protection.

The Building maintains an ideal temperature due to floor heating being installed with in the slab during construction.

Building works included extensive outdoor play area, soft fall area's and large sand pit.
